

#### 2010 West Virginia Public Library Salary Survey

#### INTRODUCTION

In even numbered years, the West Virginia Library Commission conducts a survey of salaries in all public libraries. An online survey form was developed for the 2010 survey to increase the ease of response and decrease the unnecessary use of paper. The survey asked directors to report salaries and benefits as of January 1, 2010.

This report includes salary ranges, mean and median salaries, and benefits for all library positions by operating budget and service population ranges. The report is entirely based on the data submitted by public library directors.
